False pretexts + NATO = Bombing of Yugoslavia

11 years ago, on March 24, the war returned to Europe, with the NATO bombs exploding in Belgrade - Yugoslavia. At the time, there was an intense media campaign to legitimate this action and try to confuse the peoples and youth of the world.

Not too long after the war all pretexts were rapidly shown to be lies of the imperialist governments to create the conditions for NATO to bomb Yugoslavia, causing the death of hundreds of peoples and a massive destruction that would merge the country into a crisis and destruction that is visible even today. The targets of US bombs were factories, houses, schools, embassies, trains and even hospitals! All under the pretext of fighting for «human rights».

Today, after the war and the achievement of the imperialist goal of the so called «independence» of Kosovo, the people of the region live in poverty, their countries are full of USA and NATO military forces, their roads are highways for drug and weapon traffic.

All this, so that USA, European Union and the other powers gathered in NATO could install in Kosovo their military bases and equipment and, in that manner, be closer to their goal of worldwide domination, proving that NATO is not a defensive organization, but a tool in hands of imperialist to kill or destroy who or whatever opposes to it.



If NATO was truly interested in the human rights where was it when the Albanian government decided to open fire against demonstrators, that claimed nothing but better living conditions, just some months ago? Or why would it bomb the house of civilians in Yugoslavia (1999) and everyday in Afghanistan?

Oil + Hipocrisy + NATO = Intervention in Libya

Just as happened in Yugoslavia 11 years ago, NATO and its members are using the rhetoric of the defense of the «human rights» to legitimate sanctions and a military intervention in Libya.

As people are being killed in Yemen and Bahrain for protesting against their governments, the international media tries to draw the attention only for Libya.

It is interesting that never before the situation of the Libyan people had had any interest for the NATO members that led to keep extremely good relations with the Libyan government.

The interest of imperialism in Libya has nothing to do with the Libyan people. They know that a better future for the Libyan people depends only upon the capability of that people to attain its demands and stop the repression through their organizations and internal processes, without any external intervention.

What imperialism wants from Libya is to have control of its vast oil reserves (the biggest in Africa) and other natural resources, and the possibility to install a military compound in an area that would allow it to rapidly intervene in any African country.

It is just like what happened in Afghanistan to allegedly restore democracy in a country where 8 years after the US supported candidate only wins with fraudulent elections, or in Iraq where the so called weapons of massive destruction could never be found.
